

June 2017 Block of the Month

Scrappy Daisy Block

8 ½ inches unfinished

As the name implies, this block will utilize scraps, mostly of your choosing. Use only the traditional applique method. You will select five different colored, medium toned scraps for the petals and applique to a white background. The center circle of your flower will be a small polka dot black and white print that will be provided to you. Keeping the center of each flower the same will help to unify the quilt blocks and create a striking quilt top that will surely make a teenage girl smile.

Flower Petal fabric

- Five different medium toned scraps- different colors

Background fabric (Only white solid or white tonal)

- One 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" square

Flower Center fabric

Small polka dot print (white dots on black background) **A piece will be provided to you**

Block Assembly:

1. Find the center of your background white square by folding the fabric in half twice and lightly creasing.
2. Center the applique design over the center of your white square and lightly trace the outline.
3. Hand applique the petal pieces to the background. (Note: petals will overlap slightly).
4. Hand applique the center circle to the flower.
5. Do Not trim your finished block.

All quilt blocks submitted will be used to create a quilt top for a teenage girl and donated to Sew for Hope.
